Notice of Voters List and Personal Security
Protection

The Voters List for the Town of Beausejour is open for changes or revisions in accordance with Section 36 of *The Municipal Councils and School Boards Elections Act*.

Any person who is eligible to vote in municipal elections in the local authority of the Town of Beausejour can have his or her name added to the Voters List, or have any information about the Voter on the Voters List corrected.

A person is eligible to have his or her name added to the Voters List if he or she is:

- a Canadian Citizen and at least 18 years old on election day;
- a Resident of the Town of Beausejour for six months prior to election day OR a Registered owner of land in Beausejour for six months prior to election day;
- a Student (Canadian Citizen, at least 18 years of age) attending school whose primary address is Beausejour.

Application for Personal Security Protection

A person can apply in writing to the SEO (at the address below) to have his or her name obscured from the Voters List.

A person whose name has been obscured will receive a Personal Security Certificate and identification number. In a civic election, that person may only vote by Sealed Envelope Ballot and cannot vote in person at the regular or advance voting places.

All changes to the Voters List must be completed on or before May 16, 2017.

A By-Election to elect a Councillor will be held June 21, 2017
